## Mykrolis Corporation Executives Establish Securities Trading Plans Under 10b5-1

BILLERICA, Mass.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Nov. 12, 2003--Mykrolis Corporation (NYSE:MYK) supplier of components and subsystems to the semiconductor industry, today announced effective November 11, 2003, certain corporate officers have adopted prearranged stock plans under Rule 10b5-1 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Mykrolis stated that it may initiate such prearranged stock trading plans in the future.

Rule 10b5-1 permits the adoption of a written plan for selling a specified number of share company stock at times when company insiders are not in possession of material non-public information. These plans allow insiders to sell shares of the company's stock on a regular predetermined prices regardless of any subsequent material non-public information that receive. Sales under these trading plans will occur in a systematic manner with a goal of market impact by spreading sales over a more extended period than would be available Mykrolis's traditional "window period."

C. William Zadel, Chairman and CEO, was among those officers who adopted a prearranged plan under Rule 10b5-1. Mr. Zadel holds stock options to purchase approximately 1.3 million Under Mr. Zadel's trading plan, 25,000 options will be exercised on a monthly basis should provided that the share price exceeds certain levels, and the shares issued upon exercise of options will be sold for his account. Upon completion of the plan, Mr. Zadel will hold in exercise million options.
